

Using federal, state & local funding, if you are eligible, you can receive payment assistance to a child care provider of your choice.

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NEED HELP PAYING FOR CHILD CARE - FOR CHILDREN 0 - 13?
You may be eligible for assistance, if you:

1. Live in one of the following counties: *Brown, Callahan, Coleman, Comanche, Eastland, Fisher, Haskell, Jones, Kent, Knox, Mitchell, Nolan, Runnels, Scurry, Shackelford, Stephens, Stonewall, Taylor or Throckmorton.*
2. Are a single-parent household, and you are currently working and/or in job training or attending an educational program for a total minimum of 25 hours a week or more

OR

3. Are a two-parent household, and you are BOTH currently working and/or in job training or attending an educational program for a combined total minimum of 50 hours a week or more.
3. Meet the following income guidelines (be sure to include ALL income received on a monthly basis before taxes are taken out).
